FROM THE RABBINIC TEAM: THESE AND THOSE



The parshah begins "V'eleh hamishpatim asher tasim lifneihem – And these are the rules that you shall set before them." Rashi, in common with many other commentators, points out that "V – and" joins this parshah to that of the previous week, Yitro, with its

momentous events. He cites the Midrash to say, "just as those were given at Sinai, so too were these." The mishpatim - civil laws about slaves, oxen and not cursing either one's parents or communal leaders, are as much a part of the revelation at Sinai as the more dramatic fundamental commandments.

Not only that, but they are a crucial part. The awe experienced at Sinai was a once in a national history moment. Civil laws may not be so exciting or inspiring, but they enable a society to function smoothly and justly, and are therefore an ongoing necessity. By linking the topics together in this way, the Torah uses the text to make this point.

It also makes the same point in the physical dimension. Rashi points out that the mishpatim immediately follow on from the description of how to construct the altar in the Temple. He says that this tells us that the seat of the Sanhedrin, the highest law court, should be in the Temple, providing a concrete demonstration of the close relationship between religious practice and civil law.
